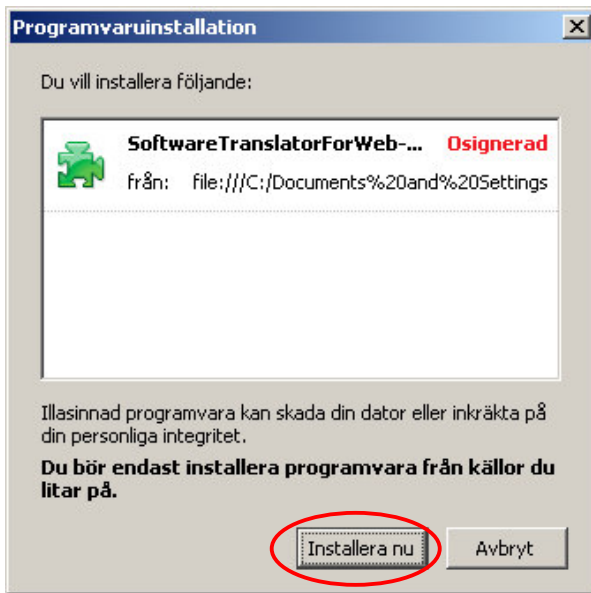


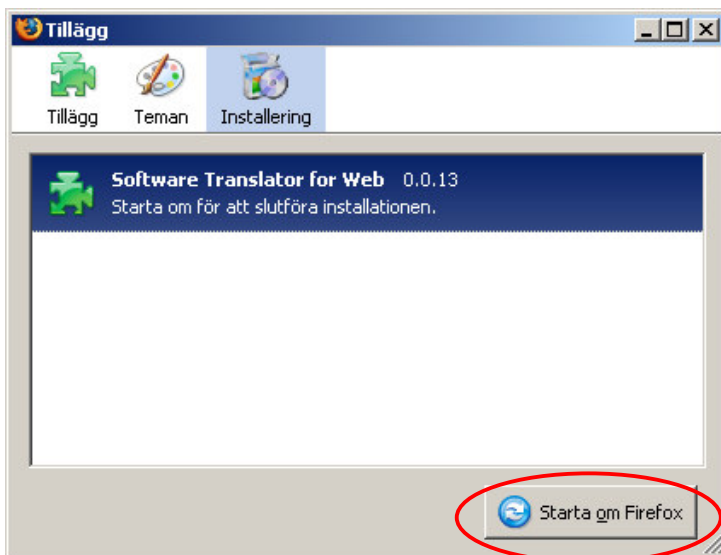
Installation of SAAS Translator:

SAAS Translator read only versions are available for Firefox and Internet Explorer, but the dictionary (lexicon) developer is only available for Firefox. If you don't have Firefox please install it at <http://download.mozilla.org/?product=firefox-2.0.0.14&os=win&lang=en-US>

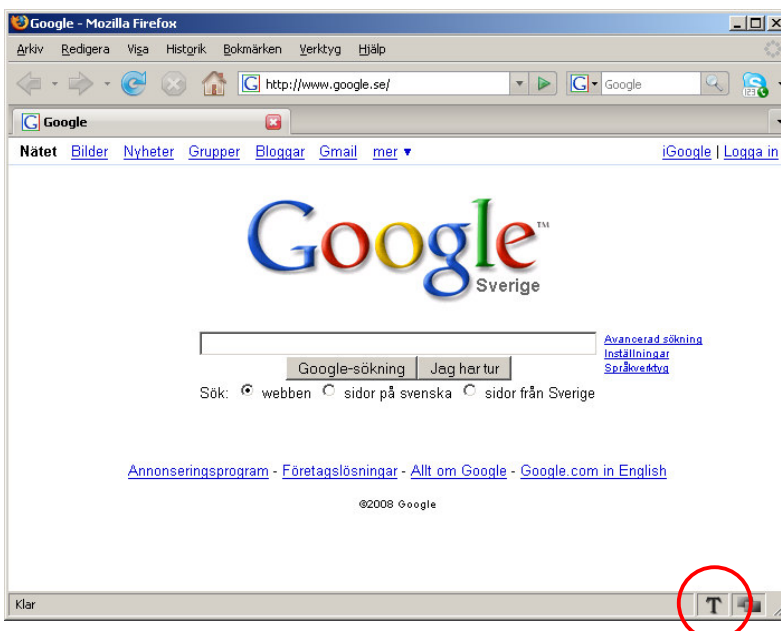


1. Start with clicking on Download SAAS Translator

2. You will see the dialog at the left, and when it says Install now click on the button..



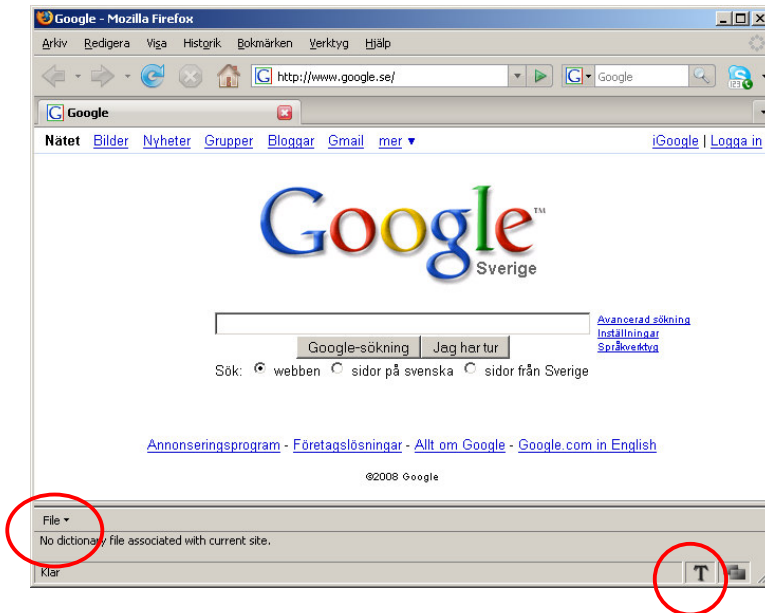
3. Click on "Restart Firefox"



4. After restart you will see a "T" (for Translation) at lower right in Firefox.

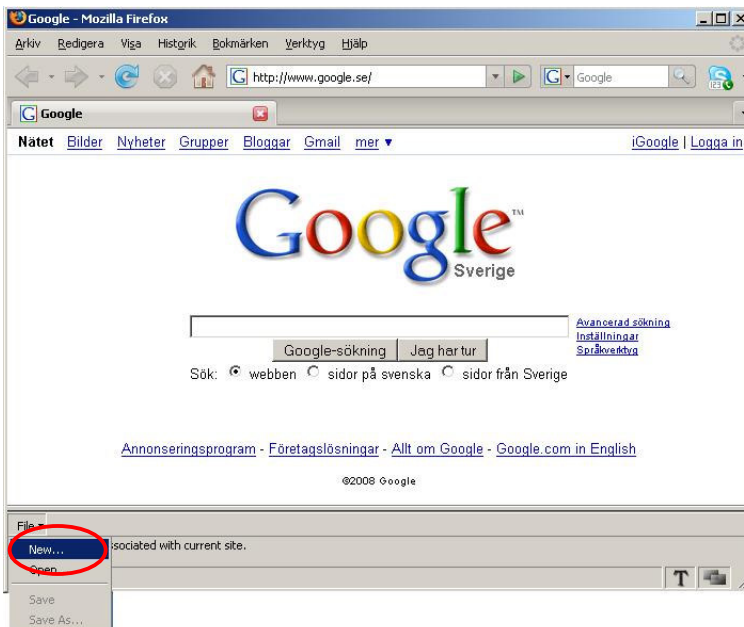
- Now installation is done!

Start translate:

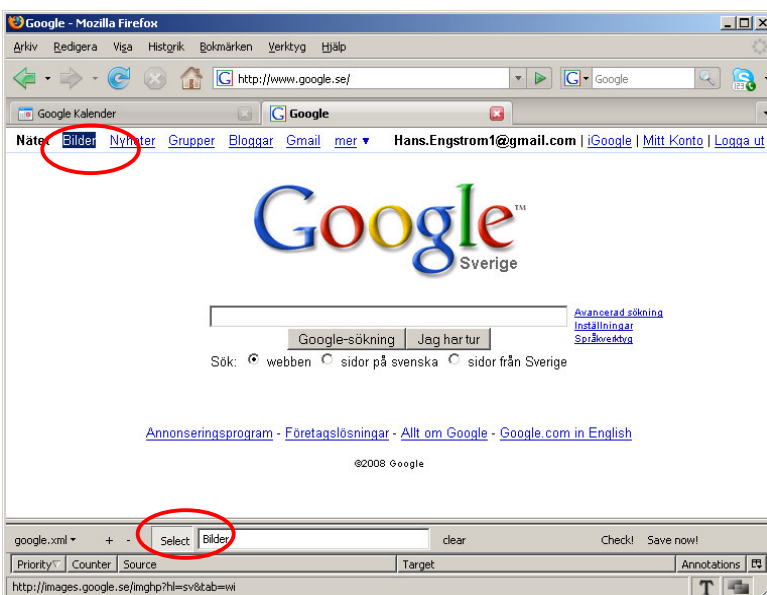


1. Click "T" (see picture)

2. Click "File"

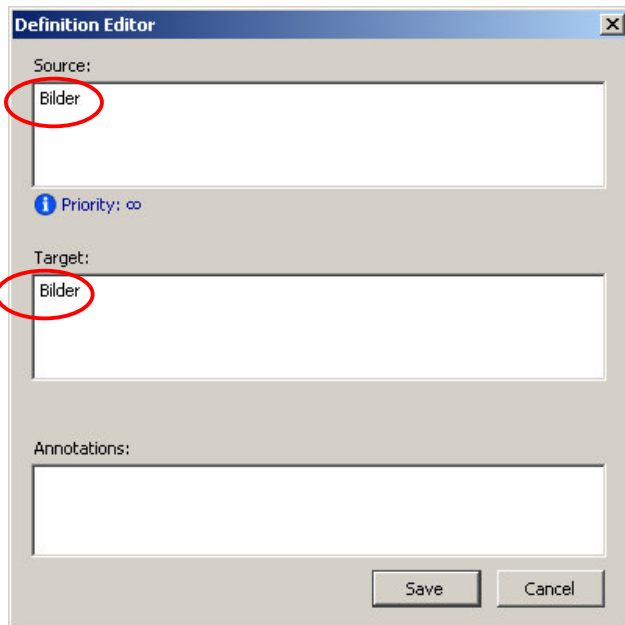


3. Click "New..." to name a new lexicon.

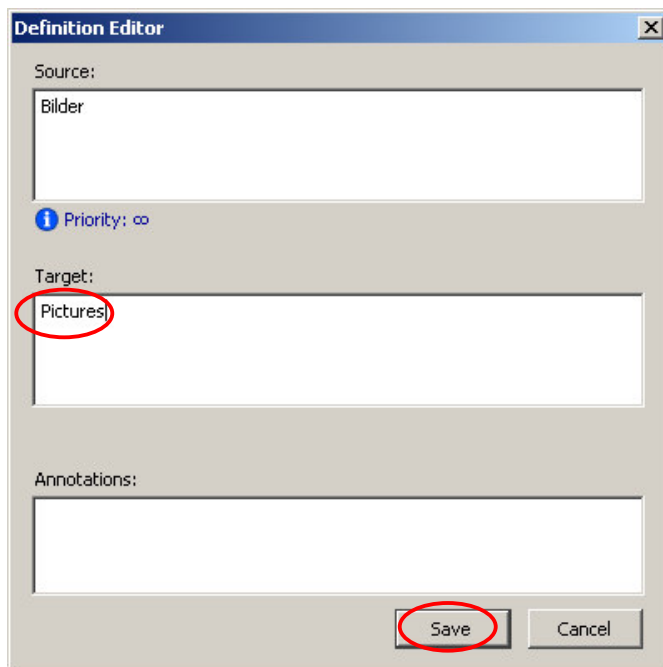


6. To start translate, click "Select".

7. Click a word or a phrase, for instance "Bilder"...

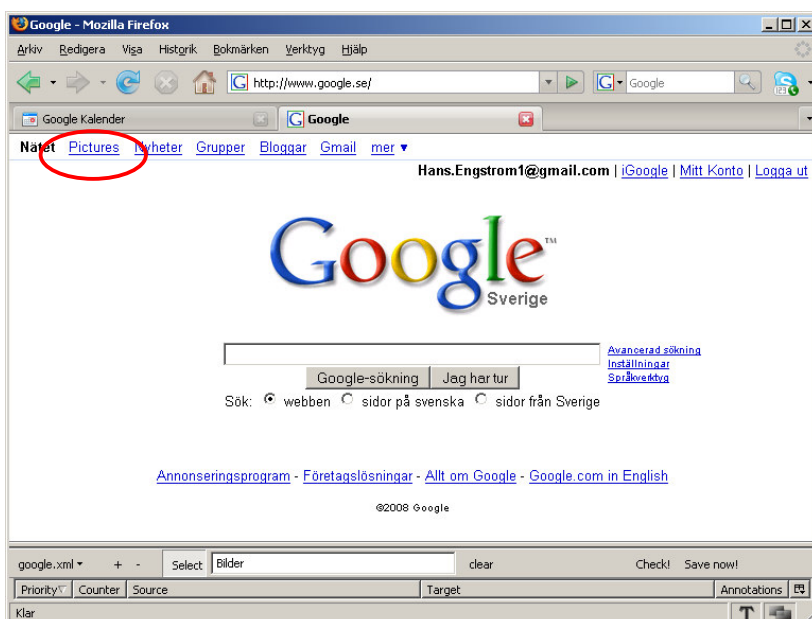


8. ...then you'll get the Definition Editor with source word (or phrase) and target word (or phrase)



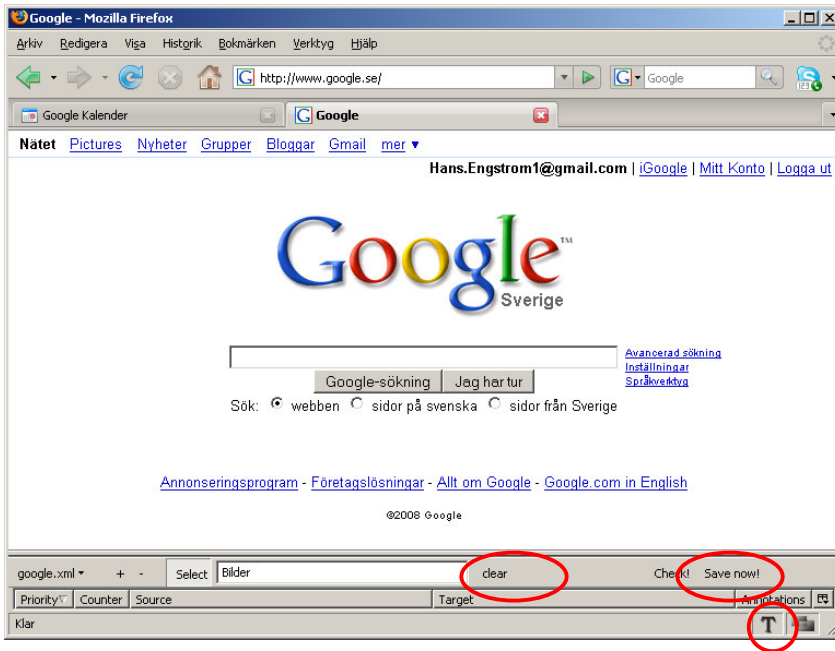
9. Click on the target word (or phrase) and translate it, to for instance to "Pictures"

10. Click "Save"



11. You immediately see your translation come through.. In this example the source word Bilder get target word "Pictures"

12. Either you continue to click on words and phrases and do the translation (see no 7 above) or you quit (see no 13 below).



13. To quit click "clear" and then "Save now!"

14. To turn the translation on and off click the "T" at lower right.

- Now you have started with your first translation. WYSIWYG (What You See Is What You Get).
